



The little charter of Coteaux d'Eos

*The characteristics of the place (school and nature refuge),
its condition (being restored), as well as its location (in the hills)
impose some common sense rules listed below.*

So thank you for...

... do not smoke or make fires on the entire site

The site is located in a natural area of massifs where vegetation (guarrigue, moor, heather ...) is very exposed to fires. Any fire and any use of devices liable to producing sparks is strictly prohibited.

... do not climb or step over the walls of terraces

The retaining walls are of dry stone and only hold in place by the organization of stones between them. They are ancient and have endured the ravages of time. They are therefore weakened, and even for some already crumbled on certain portions, making them even more sensitive to stone dislodgement.

... stay vigilant in your travels

The stones of all sizes that dot the ground, the falling branches, stumps that may remain (the site is being restored), crawling lianas, any plowing by our wild boar friends, wells and water holes are all opportunities to fall and get injured.

... respect the cleanliness of the place

by not throwing any rubbish whatsoever (paper, plastic, kleenex ...) on the floor, and making sure to comply with the little explanation displayed when using a dry toilet.

... respecter le calme du lieu

avoiding disturbing the peace of the other inhabitants of this place, whether it is men, women and children or wildlife (the site is a natural oasis and an LPO landmark).
